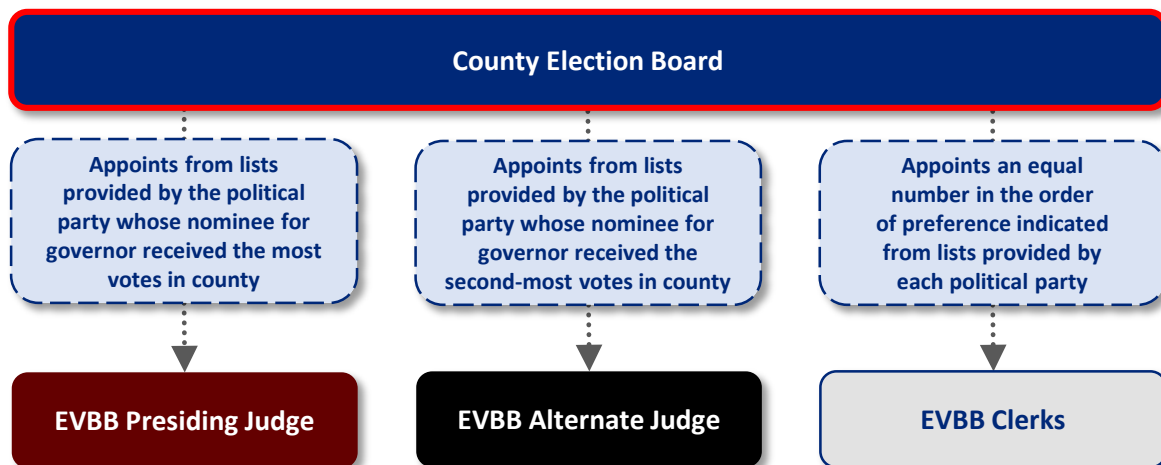


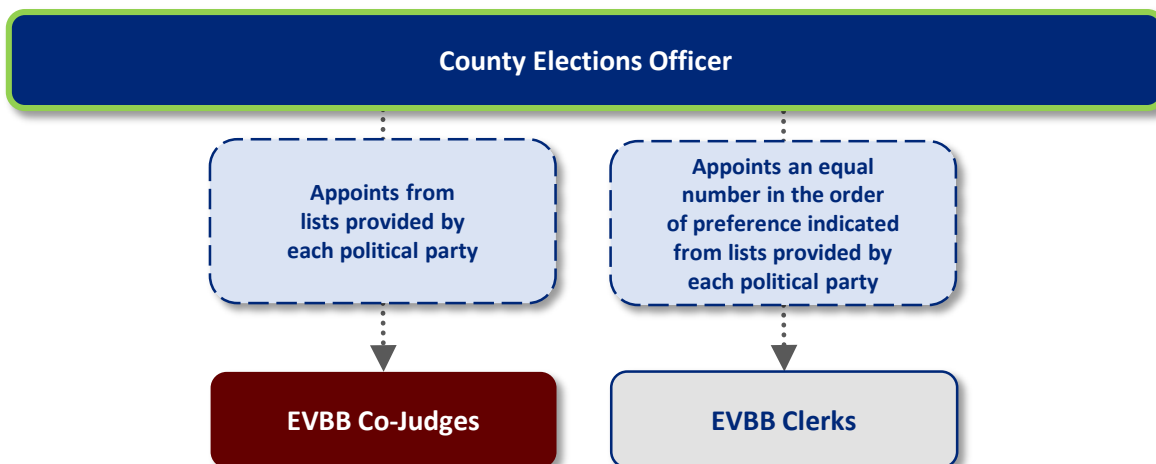


An Early Voting Ballot Board (EVBB) must be established for every election to process early voting results from the territory served by the early voting clerk. Generally, the EVBB consists of a presiding judge, alternate judge, and at least one additional member. The appointment process for the EVBB presiding judge and alternate judge follows the same statutory requirements as presiding and alternate election judges, which vary based on the specific type of election being conducted. The following charts outline the organizational hierarchy and corresponding appointment paths for all EVBB personnel.

General Elections for State and County Officers

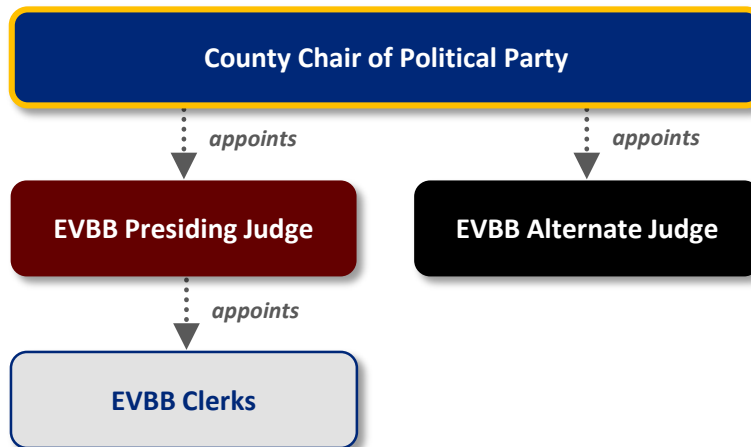


Joint Primary Elections

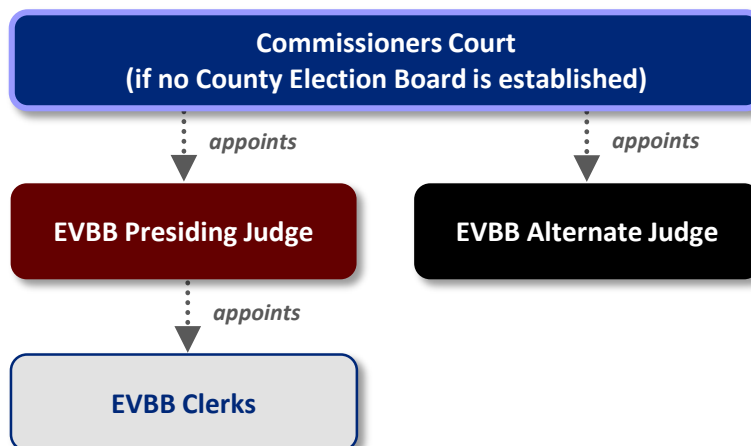




Separate Primary Elections
