

**Name of Form:**

**Notice of General Election for Other Political Subdivision.**

**Section Reference:**

**Sections 4.004, 83.010, 85.004, and 85.007, Texas Election Code.**

**Purpose:**

**To notify voters of time and date of a general election and the location of polling places.**

**Number of Copies Required:**

**One per election precinct if notice is posted in each election precinct; one copy for each registered voter if mailed; one copy for a newspaper if published; and one copy for governing body bulletin board.**

**Completed by:**

**Presiding Officer.**

**Filing Date:**

**If posted in precinct, not later than 21 days before election; or if mailed to each registered voter, not later than the 10th day before election; if published, not earlier than 30 days nor later than 10 days before the election.**

**Posted on bulletin board at least 21 days before election.**

**Filed with:**

**Presiding Officer, one copy posted on bulletin board for posting notice of meetings of Governing Body.**

**Comments:**

**A copy of the notice shall be preserved for a period of 22 months. The presiding officer shall also retain a copy of the published notice that contains the name of the newspaper and the date of publication.**

**The presiding officer of school districts must publish the notice of election in a local newspaper. Other political subdivisions must give notice by choosing one of three methods.**
