Purpose:

To officially order the election and to give notice to the public that an election has been ordered.

The governing body of a political subdivision

Filing Date:

For special election to fill a vacancy, date of order affects filing deadline. See Section 201.054 and the most recent election law calendar.

Please note that the deadline to order a special election to fill a vacancy will be the 75th day before election for a November election in an even-numbered year.

For special election on a measure, 62nd day before election (general rule) or 75th day before November election in an even-numbered year.

Filed with:

Maintained by the political subdivision who ordered the election.

Comments:

Law outside the Election Code may require additional information in the election order.

Deadline for application for place on the ballot required to be stated in order for a special election.
