INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. For a county or precinct level county office, the petition is submitted to the county judge; and to the county chair in primaries. For state and district offices, the petition is submitted to the Secretary of State; and to the state party chair in primary elections. For a municipal election, the petition is submitted to the mayor. For a school district election, the petition is submitted to the president of the school board. For all other elections, submit the petition to the presiding officer of the board of directors.
- 2. Types of electronic voting systems include optical scan, in which hand-marked paper ballots are read by a light sensitive scanner; and direct recording electronic systems, in which the voter votes directly onto the voting device.
- 3. The amount of the deposit due, which must be presented at the time the petition is filed, is based in part on the number of election day polling places or precincts. Note that in this context, precinct means voter registration precinct(s). Early voting ballots are considered to be one additional polling place or voter registration precinct. This means the petitioner should determine the total number of voter registration precincts that contained the race or measure that is the subject of the recount and compare that number to the total number of election day polling places used in the election, then include one additional polling place or voter registration precinct to that number (for early voting ballots) in order to determine the total deposit due.
 - a. \$60.00 for each election day polling location or voter registration precinct, whichever results in a smaller amount, in which regular paper ballots were used.
 - b. \$100.00 for each election day polling location or voter registration precinct, whichever results in a smaller amount, in which an electronic voting system was used.
- 4. The deposit must be in the form of cash, cashier's check, or money order made payable to the recount coordinator and **must** accompany the petition. **The deposit may not be paid with a personal check**. [Sec. 212.111, Texas Election Code]
