Certificate of Voting in Party Primary.

Section Reference:

Sections 162.004 and 162.009, Texas Election Code.

Purpose:

To provide proof of party affiliation for voters who do not have voting certificate at the time they vote.

Number of Copies Required:

One for each voter who does not have voting certificate.

Completed by:

Presiding Judge of precinct or Early Voting Clerk.

Filing Date:

After voter has qualified to vote.

Filed with:

Voter.

Comments:

The voter may use this certificate as proof of party affiliation for admittance to precinct convention. It is not necessary to complete the party affiliation certificate for voters voting in a runoff primary unless the voter requests it.
