Authority responsible for preparing the ballots.

Posting Date:

At least 72 hours before destruction.

Filed with:

The Notice of Destruction of Ballots must remain posted in the authority's office continuously for 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of the destruction. Post the Notice of Ballot Destruction on the website of the authority responsible for preparing the ballots if one is maintained by the authority.

Comments:

The sheriff of the county must be present when the defectively-printed ballots are destroyed for the following elections:

- Primary election
- Primary runoff election
- General election for state and county officers
- Any other election ordered by the governor

In all other elections, the authority ordering the election must be present when the defectively-printed ballots are destroyed.
