Name of Form:

Application for Presidential Ballot.

Purpose:

To allow voting for president and vice-president by former Texas voters not yet qualified to vote in another state.

Number of Copies Required:

One per voter.

Completed by:

The voter.

Filing Date:

If the voter is voting in person: The hours to vote after the close of early voting by personal appearance are during the clerk's regular business hours. A voter may also cast a Presidential Ballot on election day.

If the voter is voting by mail: The deadline for an early voting clerk to receive an Application for a Presidential Ballot, together with an Application for Ballot by Mail, is the 7th day before election day. (52 USC § 10502(d))

Filed with:

County Clerk or Elections Administrator.

Comments:

The voter may vote by mail by completing an application for ballot by mail in addition to this application.

Voters voting under this chapter use the balloting materials used for voting by mail.

The clerk makes a notation on the carrier envelope that it is a "Presidential Ballot Only."

Voters voting under this procedure are to be included on the precinct list of early voters and the restricted ballot register.
