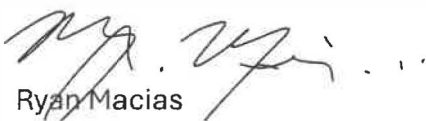

Christina,

The proposed modification contained in ECO-1781 would impact all currently certified Hart Verity systems. The modification is designed to replace an end-of-life component for the system, which is the 8 GB vDrive. The replacement component is a 16 GB vDrive that provides a greater capacity.

I agree with Ryan that this is a de minimis change that does not adversely impact the performance of the system and that does not require further in-person examination. Because this modification is designed to replace an end-of-life component with a newer component that is higher capacity and is supported by the manufacturer, I recommend approval of this modification to all currently certified Hart Verity systems.
