



TYPES OF EARLY VOTING BALLOT APPLICATIONS

The Early Voting Ballot Board (EVBB) reviews several different types of applications rather than just one standard form. As a member, you will encounter various formats during your review, so it is important to be familiar with the unique layout for each. The following outlines the specific application types you are likely to see:

Application for Ballot by Mail (Form 6-1)

Informal Application for Ballot by Mail

A written request by the applicant that is not made on the official application form prescribed by the Secretary of State. This application must comply with the statutory requirements for applying for a ballot by mail.

Note: These applications vary in appearance.

Application for Limited Ballot (Form 5-36)

Federal Post Card Application (FPCA)

Application for Presidential Ballot (Form 5-43)

Application for Emergency Early Voting Ballot Due to Sickness or Physical Disability (Form 5-32)

Application for Emergency Early Ballot Due to Death in Family (Form 5-28)
