<sup>5</sup> The charge nurse is not included as direct care staff.

<sup>6</sup> Each direct care staff shall only be assigned a maximum of four patients.

<sup>7</sup> Patient care technician (PCT).

<sup>8</sup> The number of total clinical staff includes the charge nurse.

<sup>9</sup> For seven patients, the direct care staff may be assigned a maximum of four patients and the charge nurse may be assigned a maximum of three patients.
